## A Proposal for New York January 2, 1993

Create Home in New York, a citizen task force to work on comprehensice and innovative approaches to worsening blight of homelessness. The group - about a dozen people - would include businesspeople, a few academics and activists, creative artists, religious leaders, and homeless people.

The task force should operate independently of the city's political and administrative structure, buth with official blessing. Its ;ofespan would be brief - two to five years - and financed through a apecial tax dedicted to coping with the homeless crisis. A poll last year indicated a willingness to pay such an extra, but speicific tax.

Home in New York will remind New Yorkers that it is not illegal to be poor, and create a proud showcase for successful community action un the most socially diverse, economically powerful and

culturally rich city in the world.
